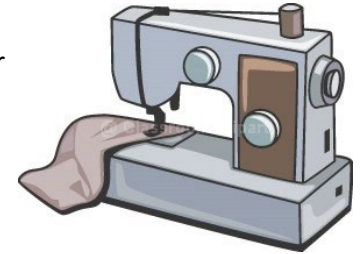
Hospitality Opportunities!
