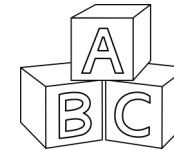

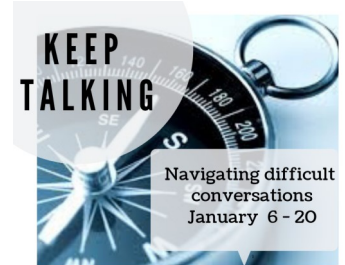


OPPORTUNITIES FOR CHILDREN
