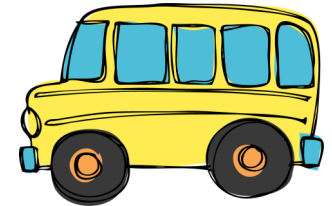


The flowers in the Sanctuary are given in memory of Valerie McCauslin by her family and in honor of Janice Lance's birthday by George (Pat) Lance.
