What's a Disciple?

Our Lenten study of discipleship continues. Disciple is a word often used in church, but what does it mean? In this study, groups will grapple with what it suggests when we call ourselves disciples, or followers of Christ, and what that commitment looks like in our lives.

The remainder of the study examines:

Healthy Relationships- Jesus designed us for love not "backbiting and devouring." Life Mission- "God doesn't want us to live confused and frustrated about our mission." Economics and Work- Jesus reminds us "that his Kingdom is everywhere we go."

Together let's discover how to grow into an influential disciple.




