afford them, allowing their children to return to school more quickly and thus not fall behind in their studies. These kits also allow parents to return to work more quickly, which can be vital to families who do not have paid time off/sick days and who are living paycheck-to-paycheck.

The Barnabas Connection for Young Adults was

created as an opportunity to embrace the example set by Barnabas. Barnabas ('Son of Encouragement') was the name given to a Levite named Joseph, by the Apostles. His story can be found in Acts where he deliberately connected with others and gave them assistance and encouragement on his travels. The Barnabas connection for Young Adults is a program designed for <u>Barnabas adults (ages 25 and older)</u> to offer friendship and encouragement to <u>Young adults (ages 18 – 24)</u> as they leave high school and venture into the workforce, off to school, into military service or stay at home.

How does it work?

1. Young adults AND Barnabas adults can sign up on the connection card or contact the ministry team by Sunday, August 12th, 2018

3. The Young adults and Barnabas adults will be matched by the ministry team.

4. After the matches are made, the Barnabas adults will contact their Young adult match. The Barnabas adult will send cards, notes, social media communications, and, possibly, small gifts to the Young adults to brighten their days from approximately Labor Day through Memorial Day.
