Would you like a personal tour of our church library and help finding DVDs, CDs, and books that will interest you? If so, please come to the library upstairs in room 213 on Sundays from 10:35-11:15. I am there most weeks, and I will be happy to share my library skills with you! I have been our church librarian for 25 years starting from scratch, and I am familiar with each of the 6,500+ items in it. If this time doesn't suit you, please call (717-774-0541), and I will work out a time to meet with you. The library is always available when the church is open, however. You may sign out materials and browse at any time.

If you are a leader of a small group, I can show you how the library can be a resource for you. We have several copies of different studies that your group might find interesting. We also have several different versions of Bibles, commentaries, atlases,



etc. that will help expand your Biblical knowledge.

Do you teach children? We have materials for all age groups of Bible stories and novels that teach values that you could share with your class. There is also a picture file that has pictures organized by topic that you can use to add to your lesson. We have DVDs of Bible stories and several collections from VeggieTales, Feature Films for Families, Bibleman, etc. We have the CD in which you could sing along. We have a large puppet selection you can borrow to help tell the stories. There are puzzles and games you can add. We also have a collection of very large books which are great because all the kids can easily see the pictures! There is also a diverse collection of books in the built-in bookcase by the desk under the "Sunday School" section which contain great ideas for crafts, games, lessons, etc.

Do you teach youth? We have a youth section of novels, devotions, graphic novels, Bibles, and many other books geared for teenagers. We have hundreds of CDs, DVDs, and a great assortment of games to play such as Bible Pictionary, Bible Apples to Apples, Bible Trivial Pursuit, Bible Scattegories, etc.!

Are you the parent of small children who is trying to teach your child Bible stories plus teach them how to read? This is my expertise since I am a certified reading specialist! .


#### **BACK TO THE BIBLE SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS**

Through mid-September we will be studying *Journey through the Bible: Mark.* We have used this excellent series with other books from the Bible. It highlights pivotal points in the Scripture; lifts up the Bible's most significant stories, events, and people, describing historical and cultural settings; includes the original language and what the passage meant for its first readers; gives insight into possible life applications, and maps out a daily plan for reading the Bible, verse by verse.

On September 23 we will start watching the DVD and studying Lee Strobel's book *The Case for Christ.* Lee Strobel, a seasoned journalist, chases down the biggest story in history--is there credi-

ble evidence that Jesus of Nazareth really is the Son of God? Tracing his own spiritual journey from atheism to faith, Strobel, former legal editor of the *Chicago Tribune*, cross-examines a dozen experts with doctorates from schools like Cambridge, Princeton, and Brandeis who are recognized authorities in their own fields. Strobel challenges them with questions like: How reliable is the New Testament? Does evidence for Jesus exist outside the Bible? Is there any reason to believe the resurrection was an actual event.
